

# Will of Wesley Smith

In the name of God Amen I Wesley Smith of the County of Carroll  
and State of Georgia being of sound and disposing mind and  
memory and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs while  
I have strength ~~do~~, do make and publish this my last will  
and testament hereby revoking all wills by me at any time ~~do-~~  
before made ~~do~~.

And first I commit my soul to God who gave it  
and my body I desire to be at the burying ground near T A Jordan's  
And my worldly estate I dispose of as follows First I give and  
bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy Smith, One hundred and fifty  
two acres off of lot of land no 47 and sixty acres off of lot  
no 50 and Ninety seven acres off of lot no 79 and Eighty two

acres off of lot No 78 all in the 5<sup>th</sup> District of Carroll County Ga  
 Also my two miles waggon and buggies all my farming  
 tools cattle and hogs of all kinds Household and Kitchen furni-  
 ture for and during her natural life or widowhood and at  
 her death or marriage I desire all of the above named property  
 of every kind and description to be equally divided among  
 my dear children by my last wife viz J S Smith M E Smith  
 L B daughter of S Smith C E Smith McSmith A C Smith and  
 Milton W Smith and any other children that my wife may  
 bear to me hereafter I also desire that my boy children above  
 named as they become of age receive a horse bridle and saddle  
 and my girls above named as they become of age or may  
 receive a cow and calf feather bed stove and bedding out  
 of the above named property or the worth of the same in cash  
 Secondly

I will and bequeath unto my beloved children by  
 my first wife (viz) W B Smith Cecilia Smith Mary Dosler  
 Ell Smith B H Smith one hundred and forty seven acres of  
 land off of lot of land No 110, one hundred and ten in the  
 5<sup>th</sup> District of Carroll County Ga or the worth of the  
 same in money being worth twenty two hundred dol-  
 lars to be divided amongst them as follows. I desire Cecilia  
 Smith, to receive out of the above twenty two hundred dollars  
 Five hundred dollars and the remainder of the above one  
 hundred and forty seven acres of land or the 2200 dollars  
 I desire equally divided between B H. W B & Ell Smith  
 and Mary Dosler provided the said W B Smith shall live  
 or become of sane mind so as to enjoy the same but  
 should he the said W B Smith die or still remain of insane  
 mind I desire his portion of the above land to be equally  
 divided Cecilia Smith Mary Dosler B H Smith and Ell Smith  
 and should either of them decease I desire their children  
 if they have any to inherit their parents portion share and  
 have alike

Thirdly

I will and desire that Jack Green or Mary Smith  
 wife of W B Smith on account of the way they have treated  
 my children W B Smith and Lucy Etta Green that they or either  
 of their heirs do not receive one cent of my property or  
 effects

Fourthly I hereby appoint and constitute James Dosler and L B Smith  
 my lawful executors to carry out this my last Will and Testameant  
 witness whereof I the said Wesley Smith to this my last will and  
 testament consisting of one sheet of paper have hereunto set my  
 hand and affixed my seal this the Thirtieth day of August  
 in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Eighty two
