Item Second

I will and bequeath to my son, William E. Johnson one undivided half interest in ~~the~~ ^{my} town of Carrollton in said County under the management of himself & mother and to manage the same as would myself if living or in other wards as I have usually done and out of the profits of the same that you support me and my son Charss Johnson that is to say if my son Charley will attend school that the expenses thereof be paid out of the profits of said Drug Store and provided further that he will during the time he is not in school that he will assist his brother W.E. Johnson in the Drug Store as aforesaid & that he have his board & clothes, Item Third.

I will and bequeath that at the death of my beloved ~~Wife~~ that the remainder be sold & equally divided between my two sons W.E. & Charles Johnson,
Item fourth I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved Wife P. A. Johnson & my son W.E. Johnson Executors of this my last Will and Testament
