Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent
and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances & condition
in life

Item 2nd I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
without delay by my Executors herein after appointed

Item 3rd I desire and direct that all of my property remain
unsold until my son Richard R. shall attain to the age of
twenty one years

Item 4th I desire and direct that my wife Mary Jane shall
have the two beds and clothing that she had when we were
married

Item 5th I desire and direct that all of my children shall
have a bed and bed-clothing as they shall become of age
and Richard R. to have one year & clothing as my Exec-
utors shall think best

Item 6th I desire and direct that my wife Mary Jane
and two sons William and Richard to have the use of the farm
and farming tools & stock until my son Richard R.
becomes of age and at that time an equal division shall
be made between my wife and children my daughter Mary's
portion to go to her and her children

Item 7th I hereby constitute and appoint my son Wm
and my worthy friend Jesse Kinney Executors of this my last
Will and Testament this January 31st 1868
