and confirm this to be my last will and testament hereby
revoking all other Wills by me made

Item 1st I desire to be buried with appropriate Christian burial

Item 2nd my Will is that all my estate consisting of lands stock
furniture utensils and household and kitchen furniture money
notes or debts of any kind, shall be equally divided up and between
my five daughters following to-wit: Elizabeth Robinson, Sarah Ann
Robinson, Mary Ann Boyle and Eliza Ann Crawford, and
for the purpose of division among them I hereby authorize my
Executor to sell and dispose of any or all of said property publicly
or privately, at his discretion

Item 3rd I consider that I have already done a fair and just
part by and for all my other children
