Rock (100) and the south half of lot
Rock (100) all being in the relevant
City of Carroll County of Georgia, well
known by the name of Fadlock's
Creek. This land and all my other

watch and such mineral interests as I have
reserved in the lands therefore sold by me,
and which will appear from the bills which
I have made - together with all other
property owned by me, I give, bequeath
and devise to my Son George S. Bonner
