Know all men by these presents that I, ROBERT LACKEY, do ordain this my last will and testament in the name and from the following to-wit:

First, I give and bequeath to my beloved wife, Nancy Lackey, all my household furniture except that part already owned by my daughter, Sarah Lackey, and Nancy M. McGuire, also all my stock of cattle except two cows, which I bequeath to my daughter, Sarah Lackey, and three cows, which I bequeath to my daughter, Nancy M. McGuire. My stock of hogs I give and bequeath to my sons Reubin P. Lackey and William J. Lackey to hold equally between them and my family to be supported out of said stock so far as pork may be required as long as they may continue to live together.

I bequeath to my wife, Nancy Lackey, my mare during her natural life. I give and bequeath to my son, Robert S. Lackey, my hoss colt. I give and bequeath to my son, William J. Lackey and my son, Reubin P. Lackey all my land with all the rights, members and appurtenances thereto belonging consisting of two lots known and distinguished as Lot Number 903 and Lot Number 970, both Lots lying in the Fourth District of Third Section formerly Cherokee County, now Cass County, containing 40 acres each to hold equally between them.

And I do hereby constitute my son, Reubin P. Lackey, my Executor to carry into effect all of the foregoing and subsequent provisions of this my said will and testament. Signed with my own proper hand and signature this the 8th day of December in the year 1839.
