I Adolphus S. Foster bequeath
I Foster and first to make an equitable distribution of the property with which I have been blessed during my family and being now of sound and disposing mind and memory do make publish and declare this instrument as my last will and testament.

It is my desire to be buried decently and according to the forms of the Christian religion which I profess, and which I trust will be sufficient for me in the hour of death.

It is my will and I hereby direct that all my just debts be paid as speedily as possible

by my beloved wife Mary Jane Fowler, and
and authority so to do under this will.

Item 8 I hereby give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Jane Fowler all of my estate both real and personal with full power and authority to her use and control the same just as I could do were I in life to be used by her in her discretion for the maintenance and education of herself and our children until the youngest child arrives at the age of twenty one years. Then it is my will and I hereby direct that my estate then left be equally divided share and share alike between my wife and each child in respect of child.

" 4 It is further my will and I hereby direct that in the event my said wife shall survive the youngest child shall have arrived at majority that my estate be then divided between my said wife and children or representatives of child share and share alike or of equal value said division to be made in kind if can be otherwise by public sale of the entire estate after thirty days notice given by my said wife as sales are usually advertised and the proceeds of such public sale (if it should occur) to be divided equally between my said wife and each child or representative of child said division to be made in the part of my children under the direction and personal supervision of some discreet and proper person named and designated by the Hon Judge of the Superior Court of Catoosa County.

" 5 It is further my will and I hereby direct that on the arrival at age of my youngest child (in the event a division has not been made under item 4th of this will prior to that time) that my entire estate then be divided between my wife and each child as described in item 4th of this will. That is to say my wife and each child to have an equal share to be divided in kind if can be otherwise a public sale of the whole estate after public notice

as prescribed in item 4th and the proceeds of said
estate sale to be divided equally between my wife
and each child or representative of child share and
share alike which said share of my wife shall stand
in lieu of all her dower interest and to my estate
Item 5th It is within my will and desire that in the event
my said wife should die during the minority
of either of our children then and in that event
I desire that the three Judges of the Superior
Court of Catoosa County shall name and designate
some discreet and proper person who will accept
the to be appointed my Administrator Extra
Testamento annexa

I do further say will and I direct that my said
will immediately upon my demise be full
and complete execution of my entire
estate without qualification or exception or
granting any bond and that she have full
power to liquidate all debts due my estate
by suit or otherwise in her name that she
manage said estate without let or hindrance
from any Court or body and in her
discretion without making any return
or return to any Court and without conforming
to any rules of law governing Executors
And I hereby appoint my friend L. J. Hackett
her Agent and assign in the management
of said estate.
