make Ordain and Establish this my last Will
and Testament.

- First I and bequeath unto my wife Fannie Calhoun
all of my real and personal property & estate
during her life or widowhood for the use and
support of herself and children and after the
death or marriage of my wife all of said
property real and personal is to be equally
divided between my children & grand children to
represent portions where the parents are dead.
- Item Second I direct that my youngest children shall have
as good an education as my other ones, and
in failure thereof I direct that the amount
of money necessary to give them an equal
education be paid to them before the final division.
- Item Third I direct that on the coming of age of any
marriage of any of my children I direct that
child's portion of my estate may be given
them from which they are to discharge all the
final distribution.
- Item 4th I hereby authorize my executor to carry out
this will without any other or other expense
and in case there is any disagreement about
the division or any other matter in relation to
this will I direct that the executor select three
disinterested men of known standing shall
decide the matter final and binding between the parties.

executors of this my last will and Testament
