State of Georgia We the undersigned witnesses state that
between ~~and~~ we were present at the Peter Baltun
residence in the County and State
aforesaid on the 29th day of September 1875 being
the day before his death which occurred at his res-
idence in the County and State aforesaid on the 30th
day of September 1875 and he being then sick upon
the bed upon which he afterwards died to General
and on the same day of September 1875 in
our presence and hearing the said Peter Baltun
was informed by Dr. A. S. Hawley his attending
Physician that his family wished to talk with
him whereupon Mr. Baltun assented for them
to do so. He was also informed by Dr. A. S. Hawley
that if he wished to make a will that he could
do so by telling the same in the presence of three
witnesses whereupon Mr. Peter Baltun took a
oath at all the persons present and was
then ask by his wife Mrs. Baltun if he wanted
her to have anything or what he wanted her
to have. And the said Peter Baltun said in our
presence and hearing that he wanted his money
his wife to have all his land and property
after his debt were paid. He then said that
afterwards said in the same conversation
that he desired his son Samuel to have the
share he had given him as the pay for him.
He was then ask if he desired for his
daughter to have her own ~~and~~ things and
he sanctioned the same as being his desire.
His statement was made in our presence and
hearing as above stated in the last illness of
Mr. Peter Baltun and under full consciousness
of his approaching death and that he did so
about twenty four hours after the same
was made.
