If a sale of property shall be necessary I wish them to select for that purpose such property as can be most advantageously sold, provided it shall be taken from property not bequeathed to my wife wholly and her children's and I authorize them to sell same at private sale if they see fit so to do.

Item (2) I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mollie the following real estate to-wit the place whereon I now reside containing 88 1/2 acres, bounded as follows, on the North by the north edge of Criers bay. East by Lomans branch and Hoggs Swamp. South by lands of S E Cherry and on the West by lands now owned by myself and the estate of H P Prescott. To have and hold the same to her own proper use and benefit during the term of her natural life remainder to my three children by her to-wit. S P Allen W Allen and Essena Allen in fee simple also the following personally, one horse and buggy

S P Allen W R Allen and Eviline Allen in fee simple also the following personally, one horse and buggy all house-hold and kitchen furniture all stock horse of which I may die seized.

Item (3) I give and bequeath to my three minor children to-wit. S P, W R and Eviline Twenty five head of Stock Cattle each.

Item (4) I give and bequeath to my wife Mollie in addition to property above enumerated all my plantation tools, including cane mill and Sugar boiler during her natural life remainder to my

Three Children above named.

Item 5. I give and bequeath the residue of all property of which I may die seized. To my Eight children as follows. J H Allen G W Allen Mary Jane Roddenberry Brown Allen Bertie Herring J C Allen Dreg Allen and G C Allen share and share alike. if living and if dead then to their children
