Second. I give and bequest to my

Subject to the following Conditions
to wit That from the Rents profits
and natural income of said Real
Estate, and Personal property my

as may be unmarried. And who
shall desire to remain with

Their mother in the same manner
 that I have done while in life.
 It is my particular desire that all
 property both real and personal belong-
 ing to my Estate, shall be and verily
 as it is until the death of my wife
 her second marriage I furthermore
 declare that the property both real
 and personal as aforesaid, shall
 amount to nothing more than
 life, estate, or during widowhood
 And immediately after the death of
 my wife all of my real estate be-
 ing bequeathed, as set forth in the
 second item of this will, to my
 wife Letitia shall be divided equally
 between and shall share among the
 following named Children, the issue
 of our marriage to wit: Jackson, my
 William, my Joseph, my Lucy,
 my and my Catherine Smith with
 James Smith. I here declare that my
 daughter Martha Lang wife of John
 Lang, has received the said possession
 to a tract of land that was consid-

declare that the property both real
 and personal as aforesaid, shall
 amount to nothing more than
 life, estate, or during widowhood
 Thia, immediately after the death of
 my wife all of my real estate be-
 ing bequeathed, as set forth in the
 Second Item of this will, to my

 Sixth I nominate and appoint

as executor of this my last will
 and Testament hereby charging
 with the faithful performance
 of all the conditions and provisions
 therein contained. believing all my
 just debts paid I here by direct my
 executor to dispose with making

Inventory or returns to the Executor
under whose Jurisdiction this will
may come. as it can work no injury
to any one Save Legatee under the Will
and also to dispense with making
adventitious debts for Creditors.
