Extract from the Minutes.

In COUNCIL, July 18, 1787.

THE Executive ever feeling a disposition to do

justice to the individual as well as to the State, came to the preceding order, and for the following reasons, that is to say, 1st. Because there appears by the statement taken from the Treasurer's Office a large proportion of the amount of Sales of Confiscated Property, both principal and interest, remains unpaid for, whereby the State is not only materially injured, but rendered incapable of doing that justice to her creditors, she should or otherwise would do. 2^{dly}. Because those who have already paid, conceive it a grievance that any partiality should exist, placing the man who has paid on a worse footing than he who never pays, whereby the

good intention of government is frustrated, and rendered abortive. 2dly. Because no government can possibly exist long, unless their internal credit is supported by a dilution of their debts, and in order that no colour of injustice may appear by this order, so as to be suspected of having dealt otherwise than impartially,—the Executive have also ordered the names of those who have funded certificates to be annexed to this publication, that the creditors may see at one view the amount of the debt still due the State.
