you to the said Mrs Brown Admin^r as afo.
on or before the 20th day of February next
to wit (Ann L. Beacroft, Peter
L. Beacroft and John Butz) Given under my hand & seal
at Savannah at the 20th Nov: 1799
in the 14th Year of the
Independence of the State

At the same time took the oath
prescribed by Law gave the
