his mercies do make and publish this my last will
and testament and desire that it may be recorded
by all as such in the first place I recommend my
soul into the hands of Almighty God who give it
and by body I commit to the earth from whence
it came there to be interred in a decent Christian
manner at the discretion of my Executors and as
to all the worldly Estate that it has pleased God
to bless me with I give Devise and dispose of
in the following manner and form first my Will
is that all my just debts and funeral expences
be paid and fully discharged.

In primis I give and bequeath to my niece Elizabeth
Fox Daughter of my Brother the late Benjamin Fox,
her Elms and Appurtenances for ever two Negroes one of whom
is named Toney and the other a boy named

John. I give and bequeath to my Niece Elizabeth
Fox Daughter of my Brother George Fox her Elms
and Appurtenances three Negroes one the name is
one Nan and the other named Bett and a girl
named Sell

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Intem I Give and bequeath to my two Nieces
Elizabeth and Elizabeth Fox daughters of my Brother
Benjamin and George Fox as before mentioned all
the remainder of my personal Estate share and
share alike to be equally divided betwixt them and
their heirs or assigns forever and my Will is in
that all the profits and proceeds that may
arise from the above bequeathed Negroes and all
lawfull demands and Debts owing to me by the
Estate of my Brother the late Benjamin Fox be
equally and truly divided betwixt my two Nieces
aforesaid viz. Elizabeth Fox Daughter of the afore-
said Benjamin Fox and Elizabeth Fox Daughter
of the aforesaid George Fox and to their heirs and
Assigns forever, and I do give and bequeath to
my Niece Elizabeth Fox Daughter of my Brother
George Fox my Bed Bed cloths and parolion and
my Will is that all my Wearing Apparel and
Chests be equally divided betwixt my two Nieces
before mentioned

Intem I Give and bequeath to my Brother John
Fox the sum of five shillings sterling Intem I
Give and bequeath to my Brother William Fox the
sum of five shillings ster, Intem I Give and bequeath
to my Brother Jonathan Fox the sum of five shil-
lings sterling Intem I Give and bequeath to my

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Brother James Fox the sum of five shillings ster
Item I give and bequeath to my Brother George
Fox the sum of five shillings sterling Item I
make constitute and ordain my Brother John
Fox and George Fox to be joint Executors of this
my last Will and Testament and I do hereby
utterly disallow revoke and annul all and
every other Testaments wills Bequests legacies
and Executors whatsover before and by me
named ratifying and confirming this and re
alter to be my last will and testament in Writing
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this twenty seventh day of May in the year of
our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and seven
ty three
