A Tract of land on St. Philips in the parish of St. Davids, and one hundred acres of land in the parish of St. Phillips adjoining Mr. Butler's lands and two hundred and fifty acres of Land in the parish of Saint Matthew adjoining lands of Mr Joseph Blay and my sister Mary Ann. also a lot of land at Hamaracaw the above lands to be sold to pay my debts.

Item, I give and bequeath the remainder of my estate both real and personal

to my beloved wife Ann Farley—
for and during her natural life—
and after her decease to the heirs of
her body and in case no heirs I
give and bequeath one half to my
loving sister Mary Winn.

Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute
and appoint my said wife Ann
Farley my executrix and my friends
~~Walter Francis Bourgeois~~
~~John Waller and~~
~~Peter Winn~~ my executors of this my
last will and Testament hereby
revoking all former wills and Tes-
tament by me heretofore made
I witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal the
third day of January in the Year
of our Lord one thousand seven-
hundred and eighty one
