I Francis Henry Harris of the Parish of Christ Church, in the State of Georgia Esq^r being in perfect health, and of sound Mind, Memory and Understanding; but considering the Uncertainty of this transitory Life do make publish and declare this my Last Will and Testament in Manner and form following: after payment, of my Funeral Charges and full Satisfaction of my just and Lawful debts; I Give and Bequeath unto James Clay, Son of my much Esteemed Friend Joseph Clay Esq^r the Sum of Five Hundred pounds, good and Lawful Money of the State aforesaid; I Give and Bequeath unto my God Daughter Catherine Clay, Daughter of the said Joseph Clay, the Sum of Five Hundred pounds, like Lawful Money; to be paid to the said James Clay and Catherine Clay, by my Executors herein after named - in the following Manner, the said Sum of Five Hundred pounds, to be paid the said James Clay, when he shall arrive at and Attain to the Age of Twenty One Years; And the said Sum of Five hundred pounds, to be paid to the said Catherine Clay, when she shall Arrive at the Age of Twenty One Years, or be Married, which ever first shall happen; And it is my Will and I do hereby Order and direct, that a Mullatto

Boy, named Jack, the son of my Negro woman
 called Betty, now on my plantation, be maintain-
 ed and properly Supported by my Executors, out of
 my Estate, And also that the said Boy Jack, shall
 be by my said Executors, Bound out to Learn, some
 good and Sufficient Trade and Occupation, untill
 he shall Arrive at and Attain to the Age of Twenty
 Years; And after the said Mulatto Boy Jack -
 shall so attain and arrive at the said Age of
 Twenty Years, then I do hereby, Manumitt, make
 free, and release from all Slavery and Bond-
 age the said Jack, and discharge him from the
 same, against me or my heirs, or any person or
 persons whatever; so that the said Jack, may en-
 joy the Liberties and Privileges of a free Man,
 under this, my Last Will and Testament; And
 all the rest residue and Remainder of my Estate,
 and Effects, both Real and Personal, Situate -
 and being in this, or in any other part of the
 World, I Give devise and Bequeath, to my dear
 Sister Elizabeth Harris, To have and to hold the
 same, and every part and parcel thereof unto the
 said Elizabeth Harris, her Heirs and Assigns for
 ever; And Thereby Nominate and Appoint
 my Friends Joseph Clay, Joseph Habersham
 and John Habersham Esq^{rs} Executors of this
 my Last Will and Testament, hereby Revoking
 all former Wills and Wills by me heretofore

made, declaring this, and this only to be my
Last Will and Testament; *In Witness*
whereof I the said Francis Henry Harris
have hereunto set my hand and seal this
Twenty Seventh Day of April in the Year
of our Lord One thousand seven hundred
and Seventy Seven.
