eighty three make this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following. I will that my Body
be buried in such a decent manner as my dear —
beloved Wife and Executors hereafter named who I
doubt not will manage it with all requisite prudence
and after my Funeral expenses, and as to my Worldly
Estate I will positively order that all my Debts be
paid— Item I give and devise unto my dear & loving
Wife Margaret Clarke for her term of life this house
wheroin I now dwell and all the Land & Tenements
I am now possessed, & to be enjoyed by her during her
Widowhood and in Case of her Marriage to be equally
divided between her and my two Children Archibald
Clarke and Mary Clarke my lawfully begotten —
Children by the said Margaret Clarke and all the
residue of my Real & personal Estate I give and devise
in the manner aforesaid and I hereby nominate and
appoint my dear beloved Wife Margaret Clarke my
Executrix, & James Storie of Savannah Executors of
this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking &
making null & void all former Wills and Testaments
heretofore by me made In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and Seal at —
Savannah in the State of Georgia the Eighteenth
day of October in the Year of our Lord 1783
