on four sides of Royal paper, And purporting
to be the last will and testament of Noble Jones
late of Savannah aforesaid Esquire deceased,
being duly sworn on the Holy Evangelists of
Almighty God Maketh Oath and Saith, that
he was present and did see the said Noble-
Jones on the day of the date of the said paper-
writing, to wit on the twelfth day of October,
in the Year of our Lord, One thousand, Seven
hundred and Seventy five, duly Sign, Seal,
deliver, publish pronounce and Declare the
said paper writing, as and for his last will
and testament in the presence of the said
deponent and in the presence of Rebecca.
Davis & Alexander Reid the two other Sub-
scribing Witnesses to the said Last will and
testament, who in the presence of the said
testator, & at his Request, and in the presence
of each other, Subscribed their names as
witnesses thereto And the Deponent fur-
ther Saith, that the name Henry Preston
Subscribed to the said Last will and testament
as a witness is his the Deponent's proper hand
writing, And that the names Rebecca
Davis and Alexander Reid also Subscribed
as witnesses thereto, are the proper hands

Writing of the said Rebecca Davis and Alexander Reid, And the Deponent further saith, that the said Noble Jones at the time of his signing & publishing the said paper writing as and for his last will and testament was of sound, perfect and disposing mind memory and Understanding.
