Will Bk B 1788-1791} ~~Thomas~~ ^{www.georgiapioneers.com} ~~Young~~ of the Parish of Christ Church in the Province of Georgia, being sick, but of sound mind and memory do make this my last will and Testament in Manner following First I Give and Bequeath to my Son William the sum of Three Hundred pounds Sterling to be paid him by my Executors when he shall arrive at the age of Twenty One Years out of my Estate as herein after directed and ordered. Secondly I Give to my Son Isaac the like sum of Three Hundred pounds Sterling to be paid at the age of Twenty One Years as aforesaid Thirdly I Give unto my son Thomas the like sum of Three Hundred pounds Sterling to be paid him at the age of Twenty One Years as aforesaid Fourthly I Give unto my Daughter Mary the sum of Three Hundred pounds Sterling to be paid her at the day of Marriage or at her arrival to the age of Twenty One Years. And it is further my Will that in case any of my said Children should die before they be Intituled to receive profits and enjoy their Legacies respectively that the Legacy or Legacies of such Child or Children so dying shall be equally divided among the survivors Fifthly to my Daughter Elizabeth Weddell I Give bequeath the Negro woman Pheby and her Children now in possession of Benjamin Weddell to her and her heirs forever Sixthly I Give bequeath and Devise unto my Loving wife Martha Young

 All my other Estate, both real and personal, I do hereby give, sell, assign, and convey unto the payment of the above Legacies of Twelve Hundred pounds and Moreover, it is my Will, that the Maintenance, and Education of my Children, or any of them, shall on any Pretence, be deducted from or out of their respective Legacies of Three hundred pounds. And Lastly I do hereby constitute, and appoint my said wife, Martha Young, whole and sole, Executrix of this my last Will, and Testament all former, and other Wills by me made. Witnesses my Hand this 11th Day of October, One thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Six.
