

This is the last Will and Testament of me
 John Fox Senior of the Parish of Christ-
 Church in the Province of Georgia made the
 Sixth day of April in the year of our Lord One
 thousand seven hundred and seventy five
 being of sound disposing mind Memory and
 Understanding. First I commit my Spirit to
 God who gave it and my Body to the dust to
 be decently interred, and the Charges of my
 Funeral I desire may not exceed the sum
 of seven pounds Sterling, and the Estate which
 it hath pleased God to Bless me with, I give
 devise bequeath and dispose of as follows. -
 First I will that all my Just debts be paid
 and discharged as soon after my Decease
 as possible. - Then I give to my Loveing wife
 Frances Fox. I give the third of all my move-
 ables and her living in the House and the
 use of my plantation during Life and such a
 part of the Labours of my Negroes to be Allowed
 her for the Maintenance of her and the Children
 and their Education, as my Executors may seem
 fitt and the remainder profits arising from the
 Labour of the Negroes to be put out to Interest or
 to be applyed to the purchasing of Negroes and
 the Lands and Negroes to be divided by Lott as
 my two Sons David and John may come of
 Age and my wife to be Joint with them in

the Casting Lotts for the Negroes alone. —
 And Lastly I do hereby Nominate Constitute and
 appoint my Loveing wife Executrix and my
 Brother William Fox and James Habersham Ju-
 nior Executors of this my Last Will, and in Tes-
 timony that this is my Last Will and Testament
 I have hereunto set my hand and Seal and
 published the same as such the day and year first
 above written. —

Jonathan Fox being duly sworn, maketh oath,
 that he was present & did see John Fox of little-
 Ogechie Senior, sign, Seal, publish and declare
 the within to be and contain his last Will and
 Testament, and that he with Joseph Fox and
 John Fox signed their names as witnesses there-
 to in the presence of the said Testator & at his
 request and in the presence of each other. And
 the deponent further saith that he verily believes
 the Testator at the signing & delivery of the said

instrument of writing was of sound mind -
Memory and understanding -
