Georgia In The Name of God Amen. I John Stork of the Parish of Saint Matthen in the State aforesaid Esq^r being in health and of sound and disposing Mind and Memory do make and ~~order~~ ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say, Inprimis I give and bequeath unto my Brothers Benjamin Stork Samuel Stork Nathan Stork and Joseph Stork, the sum of Forty Pounds Sterling each, to be paid by my Executors herein after named within eighteen months after my decease, into the Hands of my Father Nathan Stork or his Executors and for my said Brothers, Benjamin Samuel Nathan and Joseph Stork, to be paid to them severally and

respectively when they and each of them, attain the age of
Twenty years, and in case of the death of either of my said
Brothers, before he or they attain such ages then the same
to be paid to the Survivor or Survivors of them Share and
Share alike. — I then I give, devise and bequeath unto my
dearly beloved Wife ^{and to my Son Benjamin Sirk} Hannah Sirk, the whole Residue and
Remainder of all my Estate both Real and Personal, that
is to say all my Lands, Slaves, Stock of Cattle household
furniture, Plate, and Money at Interest to be freely possessed
and enjoyed by them and each of them and in case of the
death of either of them the same to become the Property
of the Survivor, to be freely possessed and enjoyed, and
to Hold to her or him, and her or his Heirs for ever. —
And Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint
my said Wife Hannah Sirk Executrix and my Brother
Samuel Sirk Executor of this my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking any former Wills by me heretofore made
and declaring this and this only to be and contain my
last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hands and Seal at Savannah in the State
aforesaid this Twenty first Day of October in the year of
our Lord One thousand seven hundred and seventy six.
