First I Will that my Just Debts, Funeral Charges and the Expence of proving this my Will be fully paid and discharged

Item I give and bequeath unto Daniel Remshardt my only Son all my real Estate except one hundred Acres of Land in Effingham County bounded South West by John Herl, North East by John Shider and South East by Land formerly Doct. Myers and Mr. Wrick Setzer but now to the Estate of the late Captain Polhill and on all other sides by Vacant Lands.

I Will that the abovesaid and described Land be sold and also all my personal Estate at Vendue, and the moneys arising therefrom be equally divided among my Dear Children, except Thirty Pound shall be taken from the above money and be paid unto my two eldest Children Daniel and Catherine for which sum I have given Mr. Vetsch my Obligation for them and then the money be Equally shared amongst my five Children viz.

Item I give and bequeath unto Daniel my Son one Share; Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Catherine one Share;

Item I give and bequeath unto Judy my Daughter one Share;

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter one Share;

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Hannah one Share.

Lastly I Do nominate and appoint my Friends Nicholas Shubert and Jonathan Lepperr of Effingham County Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me heretofore by me made in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th day of August in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and Eighty two.
