 Negroes Battle and Hogs also two Horses Viz. a grey Horse
 thirteen hands high branded on the Mounting Shoulder
 B.L. and a Flower du Luce in one, and a Black Mare
 with a White star in her forehead Branded on the Mount-
 ing Shoulder B.L. and on the near Buttock T and a figure
 of 2.

Lastly I Nominate constitute and appoint William Tren-
 field and Thomas Brownhill my Executors and my
 Wife Sophia Raynes Executrix of this my Last Will
 and Testament. Hereby revoking all former Wills to
 be null and void.
