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Chatham Co. Will Bk B. 1788-1791
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In the name of God the Twelfth Day of June 1788.
I Michael Herbock of the Parish of Christ Church in the
Province aforesaid Planter being very sick and weak in Body,
but of perfect mind and Memory Thanks be given unto God.
Therefore calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body, and
knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to die: Do
make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament, That is to
say. First I give and bequeath unto my Son Jacob Herbock
All that Fifty Acre Lot of Land whereon I now Reside
Known by the Number Situate Laying and being in the
Village of Acton in the Parish of Christ Church in the Province
aforesaid Bounded on all sides by Land Vacant at the time of
the Original Grant thereof During his natural life and after his
Decease my Will is that my Son Michael shall have the said
fifty acre lot of Land During his natural ^{life} and after his
Decease my Will is that my Son John Herbock shall have the
said Fifty Acre lot of Land for him and his Heirs forever
Also my Will is that my Beloved Wife Mary Herbock together
with my Sons Michael and John shall reside on the said
Land, my Wife during her Widowhood and my Sons Michael
and John untill they are Twenty one years of age, Also my
Will is that all my Stock of Cattle Horses and Hogs Plantation
Tools and Household furniture be kept together for the
Maintenance of my Family During the Widowhood of my
beloved Wife or until my youngest Son is of age then to
be divided in the following Manner my beloved Wife to have
the household Furniture, and the Stock and Plantation Tools
between my Sons Jacob, Michael and John Share and Share
alike. Lastly I constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Mary
Herbock and my sister Catherine Reddy to be Executric's
together with Mr. George Basil Spencer to be my Executor of
this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have
