

In the name of God, Amen, I Peter Tondee of Savannah, in the province of Georgia Carpenter, being sick & weak in body, but of sound & disposing mind & memory & and considering the uncertainty of this transitory life, knowing that it is appointed for all Men, once to die Do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in writing first I recommend my soul, into the Hands of Almighty God, hoping for pardon and forgiveness of my sins through the Merits of Jesus Christ my Saviour: and as to that Worldly Estate, wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me I dispose thereof as followeth I will and desire, that all my just Debts, be paid and satisfied, as soon as conveniently can be after my decease. Then I give and Devise unto my beloved Wife Lucy Tondee All and singular my Estate, both real and personal of what nature or kind soever or wheresoever the same may be found To hold to her my said Wife for and during the Term of her natural Life and from and immediately after her decease, then and in that Case I Give and devise the said Estate both real and personal to and amongst my own Children, to be equally divided between them, share and share alike, and to hold as Tenants in common and not as joint Tenants. And Lastly: I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my said Wife sole Executrix of this my Will: making null and void all former and other Wills by me at any time heretofore made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at Savannah, in the province of Georgia aforesaid, the Twenty first day of October, in the Year of our Lord, one Thousand, seven Hundred and Seventy five

Will "in hopes that the said Testator, would thereafter be better able to sign the same, in his usual manner, but that the said Testator, continued to grow worse, and lingered until the next evening, when he died—

At the same time Lucy Tondoe, named sole Executrix in the within Will, qualified as such

and assigns In Trust nevertheless and to and for the uses following (that is to say) to the use and behoof

of Polly Curtis the Daughter of W^m Mary Curtis of Savannah aforesaid widow and her assigns for and during the term of her natural life and from and after her decease then to the use and behoof of my
