In the name of God Amen, I Priscilla
 Permain of Savannah in the Province of Georgia
 aforesaid Widow, being weak in body of Sound
 mind memory & understanding, do make and
 declare, this to be my last will & testament
 in manner following. (that is to say) I primum
 it is my will & desire that all my Just debts
 & Funeral expences be fully paid and satisfied
 as soon as conveniently may be after my decease,
 Item, I give & devise, all my Town Lot of Land Situate
 lying & being on the Bay of Savannah aforesaid &
 known by the No 4 Lot by lying Darby Lane
 with the Houses out Houses erections & building
 thereon erected & built unto my three Children,
 Michael Permain, Priscilla Campher, the
 wife of Jeremiah Campher Planter, and Ann
 Permain to be equally divided among them
 their heirs & assigns for ever, when the younger

of my said three Children shall attain the
Age of twenty one Years, and untill the Youngest
of my said three Children shall attain the
Age of twenty one Years, it is my will & desire, and
I do hereby order and direct, that the said Lott
of Land with the Buildings thereon, be let or rented
out, for the most money that can be had for the
same, and the money arising from such rent, be
Yearly and every Year, equally divided among my
said three Children, that is to say, two thirds for
the Support and Maintenance, of the two Youngest
and the other third part to be disposed of as my
said Daughter, Priscilla, Campher, shall think
proper; - Item. I give & devise, all that my Town
Lott of Land, Situate lying & being at Hardwicke,
No 177. unto my said Son, Michael Germain, his
Heirs & assigns for ever; Item I give and Devise,
unto my said Daughter Ann Germain, her heirs
and assigns for ever, all that my five acre Lott
of Land, known by the No 16. Situate lying and
being west of the Town of Savannah aforesaid
which was Originally granted to my Brother
George Peters, to which I become intitled unto,
as his Heir at Law, together with all Houses
& Buildings thereon erected and Built; Item
I give & Bequeath, unto my said Daughter Ann
Germain, and her assigns for ever, all my House
hold Furniture, of what nature, or kind soever

Excepting one Feather Bed, & Two tables of red bay side
 Chairs, & one Pair of fire Dogs, which I do hereby give
 and bequeath, unto my said Son Michael, Germain, &
 his assigns forever; Item, I give, & devise, unto my
 Friend Mordecai Sheftall, his Heirs and assigns, all
 my moiety or equal half part, of all that my Town
 Lott of Land, Situate lying and being in Savannah
 aforesaid, known by the . No 8. in Belitha Tything
 Neck coat ward, and which was originally granted
 to my said Brother George Peters and also all those
 my two Hundred acres of Land situate lying & being
 in the parish of Saint Matthew in the Province &c
 aforesaid. - To Hold the said Half Lott and two
 Hundred acres of Land herein before mentioned
 unto the said . Mordecai Sheftall, his Heirs and
 assigns forever. In Trust. Nevertheless, & to the
 intent and purpose, that he the said . Mordecai Sheftall
 his Heirs & assigns do and shall, with all conve-
 -nient Speed after my decease Sell & dispose of
 the said half Lott and two Hundred acres of Land
 with all & singular the premises and appurten-
 -ances thereunto belonging to the best purchaser
 or purchasers, & for the most money that can be had
 or got for the same, and to sign, Seal, and execute
 such, and or suchs for perfecting such sale as shall
 as shall or may be requisite, and that the said

Mordecai Sheftall his Heirs & assigns do out
the monies arising from such Sales, pay and
apply the same, or as much, as will be sufficient
for that purpose towards payment of my said
Just Debts, and in case any overplus shall be
remaining in the Hands of my said Trustee after
payment of my said Debts, then my Will & desire is,
that he do pay the sum of Twenty Five Bonds of
Georgia Currency unto my said Daughter, Priscilla
Campbell, and in case any more monies shall re-
main in his Hands after such Sales & payment
as aforesaid, then it is my Will & desire, that my said
Trustee his Heirs and assigns do and shall pay the
same unto and among my said two Children,
Michael, and Ann, Share, and Share alike, and
the rest residue and remainder of all my said
Estate, both real, and Personal, and not herein
before disposed of, I give & devise the same, &
every part thereof unto & among my said
Son, Michael, Germain, and my said Daughter
Ann, Germain, to be equally divided between
them, Share and Share alike, their Heirs and
assigns forever, and Lastly I do hereby ap-
point, constitute and appoint, the said Mordecai
Sheftall, Sole Executor of this my last Will and
Testament, and Guardian of the persons & Estate
of my said Son, Michael, Germain, and my said

Daughter ann Germain, until they shall respec-
tively attain the age of twenty one Years, hereby
revoking all former will, or Wills, by me at any
time heretofore made, and do Declare this only
to be my last will & Testament, In witness
Whereof, I the said. Priscilla Germain, the Testatrix
have herunto set my hand and Seal, this Tenth
day of November, in the Year of our Lord one
thousand Seven hundred and Seventy six; —
