

Georgia in the name of God the Father Son and
Holy Ghost amen - for thus saith the Lord
settle mine House in order for thou shalt die
and not live - therefore I take witness of this
city of Savannah Ga. being in good health
and of a sound & disposing mind memory &
understanding - that considering the uncertain
of human life do make this my last will and
testament now & yearly following & that is to
say first I command my Slave to the hands of
God the Father now & Holy Ghost who gave it to
my Master and my only desire to the earth to be
recently buried among Christian like manner and
in full and consonant all which worldly estate as
he pleased God to bless me with I give & bestow
of the same in the following manner viz
it is my will and desire that all my just Debts and
funeral expenses be fully paid & satisfied
it is my will and desire that immediately
after my decease my Slave to be buried & to
be sold and dispose of all that my said Slave
buildings & houses & lands & effects
situate at the corner of Bernard & Duke street
it is also my will and desire that my house
and lot which I now occupy number twenty three
Liberty road, be also sold by my Executor herein
after named immediately after my decease - and
I will and direct that the money which may arise
from such sale be so soon thereafter as possible
transmitted by my Executor to Germany - and I do
by these presents give grant will & transfer to my said
Executor full power & authority to grant bargains
sell & convey all those my aforesaid two lots above
with the improvements thereon to any person or
persons and their heirs forever by all due &
such lawfull ways & means in the law

my license and all movable property which I may die
possessor of at the time of my death my executor is
to sell & dispose of - and the money which will arise
from the sale of any two hundred and twenty dollars
and other property which I may have :
I will and direct that the money from such sale be
sold or thereafter as possible transmitted by my
executor to Germany - there to be distributed so
equally as aforesaid is incapable - that is to say
to my cousins the children of my Uncle
Smith of the Parish & village of Lehenbach
in Germany the sum of two hundred dollars
equally to be divided among them - three being
alive and if any of them shall at the time of
my decease have departed this life leaving
them - then each of them to have the share of the
said two hundred dollars which their
respective parents would have been entitled to
and they continued alive

Item - I give and I agree to the Poor
Parish of Lehenbach a value of one hundred
dollars of the children of my brothers & sisters & to
have a account doct them out hundred
dollars which is to be paid out for buying
books to them and other good books for the
religious education of the children of the poor
for I desire this that when the poor Parents get
the money they forget of buying books for their
children but think other uses of it therefore you
will pay out this hundred dollars of buying
books and other good books for them as fair as the
sum of one hundred dollars will reach
Item - I give and agree to the Poor of the
Parish and village of Dernbach and moreover
of Hochkirch in Germany the sum of one
hundred dollars is to be paid there
firstly because its greatest

The inheritance thereof is to bear Books and to pay their
School money at that Parish of the Poor Children -
that you might know themselves what they are
entitled to every year - as it is my sole place
and I myself have the management thereof do
know the extreme want of Education because my
parents were poor and could not afford to do
give me education therefore I can not neglect
but to assist and bequeath some money for their
education at what cost but left me with
them - If at the time of my decease there be any
money in hand which shall be immediately after
my decease as soon as possible thereafter be
transmitted by my executor to grammar
School - at the time of my decease there shall
remain living the surviving wife or Husband
of a Brother or Sister of me whose Brother or
Sister has died without leaving issue then to
each such surviving wife or Husband I give
and bequeath the sum of one hundred dollars
and as for and concerning all the rest residue
and remainder of my estate whatsoever - whether
real or Personal - I give devise and bequeath
the same to my Nephews and nieces the children
of my Brothers & Sisters equally to be divided
among them share & where none
and in case at
the time of my decease any of my said nephews
or nieces shall have departed this life leaving
a child or children then it is my will that
such child or children do take such proportion
of my said estate as his or their respective
father or mother would have been entitled to
had they remained living - and as my nephews
and nieces are all born and baptized under
true evangelic religion which is built upon the
foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ
himself being the chief corner stone
in all the building fully framed

goest unto an holy temple in the Lord...
whom ye also are anointed together for an habitation
of god through the spirit Till we all come in
the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of
the son of god into a perfect man with the
measure of the stature of the fulness of christ
that is to say if any one of my nephews or wives
change there true evangelish religion and take
up with any other outward eye thinning false
religion or there lying books and cast away the
sweet and wholesome word of god which god
the Father had sent downe through his son
our saviour which is one of cut off short and
knowledge him or his not as a Nephew or wife
so ye therfor not unequally yoked together with
unbelievers for what fellowship hath righteous
ness with unrighteousness and what communi
cation with darkness and what concord
with Christ with Belial or what part hath he
that believeth with an infidele and what
agreement with the temple of god with idols
for ye are the temple of the living god if you
remaine in your true evangelish religion and
by the sweet and wholesome word of god as god
hath sent it I will dwell in them and won't in
them and I will be their God and they shall be
my people wherefore come out from among
them and be ye separate saith the Lord and
touch not the unclean thing and I will receive
you for thous false unwilling feigned religion
with their false and abut gods and the false
prophet with his lie Books those are the unclean
things which are against god and his word for the
are commandment of men and not of god ther
for depart and be ashamed and touch not the
unclean thing and I will receive you and I
will be your God

daughter with her and dimly I see her and
say that it is an evill thing and better that thou hadst
invented the Lord thy god teacher repeat and be
converted that your love may be blotted out this is
yours voice to do well then ought you not to praise
god that sent his holy spirit in time to quicken
your heart to live with christ and to determine to
that god you are shortly to appear before and
consider how propounding it will be to men if you -
slight it upon which proceed god to slight your voice
when you cry to him and stop his ear against the
voice of your supplication you will provoke god
to cease from being a reprover to you so that he
will speak to you no more you will provoke him
to bring heavier judgment on you off a short
law his word of justice against you as you can
see at it is drawn that he will smite it up no more
therefor come out of her my people that we be not
partakers of her' because her cities have reached
unto heaven and god hath remembered her iniqui-
ties therefore pray ye our father which art in heaven
hallowed be thy name thy kingdom come thy will
be done in earth as it is in heaven whereas angels
which are greater in power and might bring not
riding accusation against them before the Lord but
these as natural bridle beasts made to be taken and
destroyed speak evil of the things that they under-
stand not and shall utterly perish in their own
corruption and shall receive the reward of unrighte-
ness as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day
time effects they are and blemishes sporting them
deceives with their own deceivings why do ye not
understand my speech even because ye cannot hear
my word ye are of your father the devil and the
lust of your father ye will do he was a murderer
from the beginning and abode not in the truth
because there is no truth in him when he speaketh
ye shall see the speaketh of his own for he is
the deceiver of it

These are the fruits of it when men charge you -
religion will cast away the sweet and wholesome word
of God therefore know ye the truth: and the truth
shall make you free. Then Jesus answered them verily
verily I say unto you whosoever committeth sin is
the servant of sin and the servant abideth not in
the house for ever: But the son abideth ever if the son
therefore shall make you free ye shall be free indeed
then said Jesus and because I tell you the truth ye
believe me not verily verily I say unto you if a
man keep my sayings he shall never see death -
Jesus saith unto them I am the way and the truth
and the life no man cometh unto the father but
me and whatsoever ye shall ask in my name that
will I do that the father may be glorified in the
son if ye ask any thing in my name I will do it
if ye love me keep my commandments and I will
pray the father and he shall give you another
comforter that he may abide with you for ever even
the spirit of truth whom the world cannot receive
if I had not come and spoken unto them they had
not had sin but now they have no cloke for their sin
he that hateth me hateth my father also he that
rejecteth me and receiveth not my words hath one
that judgeth him the word that I have spoken
the same shall judge him in the last day: therefore
repent ye and believe the gospel which were
preached through Jesus Christ our Saviour which
is his body the judgment of him that believeth all is
all and he is before all things and by him all
things consist and he is the head of the body
the church who is the beginning the first born
from the dead that in all things he might have
preeminence: for it pleased the Father that in
him should all saints dwell: for so that there
is no other way to be saved But through Jesus
Christ have you all to Christ as your only friend
and your the world thou hate him and then ha

not hear his name. he that believeth on him he is not
condemned. but he that believeth not is condemned al-
ready. because he hath not believed in the name
of the only begotten son of god verily. yea
for to you the hour is comynge. and now is thys
the dead shall hear the voice of the son of god
they that hear shall live. and ye will not come to
me till ye might have life. I receive not honour
from men but I know you that ye have not the
love of god in you. I am come in my fathers name
and ye receive me not. it is written. he that is in his
own nature. him ye will receive. this is the world. now
is hellishing for they cannot endure the truth. but
love the lie. is not the world the devils and all
that dwell therein. then again are ye children of
the devils. But his citizens called them ambulant an
epage after him. saying we will not have this man
to reign over us. for I have made upon them that unto every
one which hath shold me give. and from him
that hath not even that he hath shold. at laken
awair about him. but these wroght exorcists. reholt
redholt not that I shant reign over them bring
hither and slay them before me therefore dñe to christ
and pray to god for his mercy for evry moriorous
sinner haue been pardoned but stand on it and it is
still offered in the paper to the rule of sinners though
god lothes all the sins whilk the world would committ
yet these did not hinder him from saving the world. or
that he gave his only begotten son to death to save so
many as woulde becomme and refrest so that the time of
our man com mearle god haue ioying his kinde
and forgiuing his sins. when he sincerely refrest to
refrest and believe the cry of the most grieuous sins
that are recorded. such as these of solom: could never
reach higher than unto heaven. but dauid abhors
that the misnes of god is great. and reaches up high
than the heavens. so that it overtoppeth the rest
of all our sins if the misnes of god be greater.
his wordes. I must surely be greater than all

Again I say before you the infinite value of
christian blood - when it is not the blood of a mere
man - but the blood of god - and are there any
sins so great or guilt so heinous - but the blood
of god can wash away - surely god was made
flesh - and shed his blood - not for lesser sins only -
But for great sins also - he was truly discouraged -
yed - the least drop of this blood is of more merit to
procure the mercy of god for our salvation than all
our sins can be of force to provoke the wrath of god
for our damnation - why - the greatest of our sins
are but the sins of a man - but the least drop of
christian blood is the blood of god - moreover - this
to heart and mind at the willingness and readiness
of our redeemer to sacrifice all sinness that came to
him in the days of his flesh though driven to do
so - by his and affliction - so that he never forsakes
us even without cause - that they same day

greatest dishonor upon the divine majesty - and is a
sin more heinous than all the sins told - he was bese
fet as ye thinke of perfury who hath solemnly
sworn that he desires not the death of a sinner -
but rather that he should repent and live god
was delighted with same for sparing him

his mercy than for murdding his brother and scolding
judas for hanging himself than for betraying his
Master; why? because that by their despair they would
make the sins of mortal men greater than the
infinite mercy of the eternal god: therfor we cannot
im prayer to god for the forgiveness of your sins
and be sober: be vigilant: because your adversary the
devil as a roaring lion walketh about seeking —
whom he may devour: whom resist: last in the
faith: for the anse saying with a double voice: hear
god and give glory to him: for the hour of his
judgement is come: and worship him that made
heaven and earth: and the sea: and the mountains.
of waters: for the kingdom of god is at hand: the
time is fulfilled: for the devil is come down unto
you having great wrath: because he knoweth that
he hath but a short time: for the power is given
unto the false prophet over all hindreds and
tongues: and nations: for the time is come that
they do not endure sound doctrine: but after their
own lusts thus: they heape to themselves teachers
having itching ears: and they shall turn away
their ears from the truth: and shall be turned
unto fables: therfor not giving heed to those
tables and commandments of men that turn
from the truth: therfor god his unto them that
are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure: but
even their mind and conscience is defiled: ther-
fore profets that they know god but in works: they
denying him being abominable: and disobedient
and unto every good work reprobate: men of every
mind reprobate concerning the faith: and even
as then shd not like: to retain god in their know-
ledge: god gave them over to a reprobate mind
to do those things which are not convenient:
being filled with all unrighteousness: fornication:
wicked lusts: covetousness: earthly minded:
full of envy: murder: debodie: deceit: with

wispered backbiter. father of spot and his record dis-
pitfull proud vaadlers inventors of evil things
disobedient to parents without understanding
covetous brothers without natural affection
implacable murderers. but this is what thou saiddest not
so if you change your religion & cast away this
saint and wholesome word of god the only book
which is jesus christ the way the truth and the life
for there is no other way to be saved but the only way
to receive by the birth and the truth shall make
you free if the true master make you free ye shall be
free indeed this is the word that i never said unto you
there are two masters for either he will hate the one and
love the other or else he will hate to the one and despise
the other he cannot serve god and mammon therefore
cannot you touch them neither thing. these
mysteries lie backes to the base pro that you did the
same former over you to rebuke you with such stony
and sour words that you will think little of
your son his word even as our enemies saith well it is good
but if the rest were lost his favour when with that it
is clear enough it is neither fit for the land nor yet for the
sea shibboleth but more easie cast it out he that hath ears to hear
will hear near the true and wholesome word of god is a
good thing but if you are soon slackers in mind and
failing hearts their cometh the devil and taketh away
the word out of your hearts lest they should believe
and be saved consider that gods command to you is to
abide by me presently without any delay to day
ye can hear his voice bawling out your hearts go
in the ways of the world well gods voice to you to
serve his servants is to say but the devils voice is to
morrow and nighly of the day will your heart be to
forsake it is your resistance to obey the voice of your
creater and friend and not of your enemy and
destroyer ready to doe them all in health to morrow
to morrow they must be in hell to day christ is ready
to receive to him to whom he saidst i am sent

cometh little will let unto he be taken out of the world
this is to say he will let until the bush be taken out of
the world little children it is the last time and we
have heard that such is it that he cometh now he
