It is my Will that all my just debts be paid as soon as convenient, decrease as may be, and for that purpose I give my Executor full power to sell all or any Tract or Tracts of Land I may be possessed of and to make Titles to the same I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Morgan the sole use of my house & Lot in Savannah and Negroe Slaves during her natural life as also an equal part of one third of a Stock of about one Hundred head of Cattle with my children. -

I Give and bequeath unto my three children William, Thomas & Ann. Morgan the rest of my Estate to be equally divided amongst them share and share alike. -

And lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute my beloved wife Elizabeth Morgan, Executor of this my last Will & Testament

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hereby revoking all former Will and
Wills by me heretofore made. In Wit-
ness whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and
date this seventeenth day of April in the Year
of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and Seventy Eight -

 last last Will and Testament. I do hereby utterly revoke all former Testament Wills
