God / and calling to mind the uncertainty of
human life, on this Day, the sixteenth of Novem-
ber in the Year of our Lord one thousand -
seven hundred and eighty six, months and
publish this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following -

First my Will and desire is that all my
just debts and funeral expenses, be paid and
satisfied as soon as may be after my Decease
and as to such estate as I may dispose
of, I give devise and bequeath in manner
following, that is to say, I give to my -
husband James Simpson 'if among
the living / the Sum of Five pounds
Sterling to be paid unto him within
Six months next after my Decease -
I also make free and legitimate
after my Decease my Negro Girl
Sharon named Belia now of about three

Years of age, also I do give devise and ³⁰⁰
bequeath, all the rest and residue of all my
Estate both real and personal of what kind
soever, as in what manner soever they be unto
Mr Daniel Burns, and David Montague
154th both of Savannah, jointly and to
be equally divided between them.

And lastly I do nominate, make and appoint
the said Daniel Burns and David
Montague Executors of this my last
Will and Testament to take care and
see the same performed according to my
true intent and meaning, hereby
revoking all former Wills by me hereto-
fore made. In witness whereof I the
said Winifred Simpson have to this my
last Will and Testament set my
hand and Seal the Day and Year
first above written.
