do make and declare this to be my last Will and
Testament. first I desire to be decently buried
and after my lawfull debts and Funeral char
ges are paid. I leave my Estates follows that is
to say.

I give devise and bequeath to my Daughter
Mary Ann one Track of Land containing Two
hundred Acres on the South side of Altamaha
and four Negroes Philip Affa Clarissa Tuly to
her and her heirs

I give devise and bequeath to my Son Benjam
in five pounds Sterling

I give devise and bequeath to my youngest Son
Jacob one Negroe Tonie

I give devise and bequeath to my dear and lov
ing Wife Elizabeth one Track of Land contain
ing Three hundred Acres on Saint Marys to her
and her heirs I leave the remaining part
of my Personal Estate to be divided equally
betwixt my wife Elizabeth and my Three other
Sons David Richard and Josiah I leave the
remaining part of my Real Estate to be di
vided equally betwixt my Three Sons David
Richard and Josiah and if any of my Sons
should die before they come of Age their

Brothers shall be their heirs and lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my Brother John Fox and Jonathan Fox and my son David to be my Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking any former will or wills by me heretofore made in witness whereoff I have unto set my hand and seal this twentieth first day of January in the year of our Lord 1783.
