 Impressed It is my will and desire that my

funeral Expenses and all such debts
as I shall justly owe at the time of my
decease to be paid and satisfied as soon as
conveniently may be after my decease.

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my
beloved brothers and Sisters Hugh Robt,
Donald Robt, Sarah Robt and Ann
Wright the Widow of Mr. Shadrach
Wright deceased all the rest and resid-
ue of my Estate both Real and Personal
of what nature of kind soever the same
may be to them and their Heirs abso-
lutely for ever to be equally divided share
and share alike.

And lastly I do hereby nominate
and appoint my said brother Donald
Robt and Samuel Chapman of
Savannah Gentlemen Executors of
this my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking any Will or Wills
by me heretofore made, In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal at Savannah the
Thirtieth day of May in the Year of
our Lord one thousand Seven
hundreds and eighty three.
