Province aforesaid, Esq<sup>r</sup>. being weak in Body but of  
sound and disposing Mind, Memory and Understand-  
ing, do make and declare this my last will, and  
Testament in Manner and form following that is to say  
Impresious I desire that all my just debts and funeral  
Expenses be paid and discharged, as soon as conveni-  
ently may be after my Decease, Item, I Give and  
devise unto my Daughter, Ann all those my two  
Tracts of Land, whereon I now reside, Situate and lying  
on Cherokee Hill in the Parish and Province aforesaid  
and Containing about Three hundred and Eighty  
Acres To have and to hold, the same unto my said  
Daughter, and her Heirs forever, Subject to the  
Contingency herein after mentioned, Item, I Give  
and devise unto my son, Thomas, all and singular  
the rest and Residue of my Lands and Real Estate,  
whatsoever, within the Province aforesaid To have  
and to hold, the same unto my said son Thomas  
and his Heirs forever, Subject also to the Contingency  
herein after mentioned, Item, I Give and bequeath  
all my Negro Slaves and other personal Estate, of  
whatsoever Consisting or wheresoever, being unto my  
said son and Daughter, Thomas and Ann to be  
Equally divided between them share and share.

alike; And I direct that the same be delivered to  
 them at the Age and Subject to the Contingency  
 herein after mentioned that is to say I direct that  
 the one equal Moiety or half Part of my said Ingres  
 and other personal Estate be delivered over to my  
 said Son when and as soon as he shall attain the  
 Age of Fifteen Years And that the other equal  
 . Moiety or half part thereof be delivered over to  
 my said Daughter when and as soon as she shall  
 attain the Age of Twenty One Years or Day of Marriage  
 which shall first happen To have and to hold  
 the said respective Moieties unto my said Son and  
 Daughter respectively for and during the Term of  
 their Natural Lives and hereafter To have and to  
 hold the same unto the Issue of my said Son and  
 Daughter respectively forever in such Manner  
 as my said Son and Daughter shall by Will or  
 otherwise direct and appoint; But in case of the  
 Death of my said Son and Daughter before they  
 arrive at their several Ages before mentioned or  
 in case of their Death hereafter without leaving  
 any Issue living at the time of their several  
 Deaths or in case of the Death of their respective  
 Issue (should they have any before they come upon  
 them) I do hereby give devise and bequeath all and  
 singular my Estate both Real and personal before  
 mentioned unto my Brother Richard Wyll of  
 the Parish and Province aforesaid his Heirs

Executors, Administrators and Assigns forever, Upon  
 this express Condition, that in Case the said. Son of the said. Richard Wyllly shall live to the age  
 of Twenty One Years, that then the said. Estate, Real  
 and personal, be delivered over to him, and thereafter  
 to hold the same to him, his Heirs, Executors, Adminors, &  
 assigns forever, Item I direct that such of my Negroes  
 and other personal Estate, as may be left after the  
 Payment of my Debts, be kept together, and employed  
 by my Executors herein after named for the Benefit  
 Maintenance, and Education of my said. Children, &  
 untill they shall respectively be intitled to draw  
 and receive their Portions thereof under the foregoing  
 Clauses, Lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute  
 and appoint my said. Brother Richard Wyllly, and  
 James Ashersham Junr of Savannah in the premises  
 aforesaid my Executors of this my last will, and  
 testament. And Thereby revoke, annul and make  
 void all former Wills by me at any time heretofore  
 made, and Declare this Only to be my last Will,  
 and Testament In Witness whereof I have  
 hereunto set my Hand and Seal at Cherokee, Will  
 aforesaid this Twenty fifth day of May in the Year  
 of Our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and  
 Seventy four and in the fourteen<sup>th</sup>. Year of his  
 Majesty's Reign.

Codicil to my Will.

I William Wylly of the Parish of Christ Church  
and Province of Georgia do hereby manumit and  
free make for my Mulatto Boy named Ben,  
the son of my Negroe Wench named Nanny not  
withstanding any thing said in my above Will  
and also I direct that My son Thomas shall  
inherit my Two Tracts of Land on Cherokee Hill  
subject never the less to the Contingency mentioned  
in my said Will, and that my Daughter Nancy  
shall have in lieu thereof a certain Tract of Land  
on Ogeechee containing about Two Hundred Acres  
subject also to the Contingency mentioned in my  
said Will. And lastly it is my desire that

My Executors mentioned in my said Will, dispose  
of any part of Lands, should they think it more  
for the Interest of my Children, paying to which  
executors of my said Children, (when they come of age)  
the Land, or Lands, belong to out of my Personal  
Estate, the Amount of what the Land, or Lands  
are sold for - In witness whereof I have here-  
unto set my Hand and Seal, at Cherokee Hill,  
this Twenty sixth day of May in the Year of Our  
Lord, One Thousand seven Hundred and Seventy  
four, and the fourteenth Year of His Majesty's  
Reign.
