like amongst my children
which survive and I appoint
John Perry and Phostion
Orthon my respectable Sons in
Law to be my whole, sole -
Executors to this my last Will
and Testament and Witnesses -
whereof I have hereunto set
my hand, seal the day and date
before written And it is further
my Will & pleasure the Land
belonging to my estate to be
disposed of as follows: Item

I give & bequeath to my free sons
all my land and my eldest son
Michael to have his first choice
and so down to the youngest son
and the said land to remain in
the possession of them & their heirs
unsold for ever
