 and State of Georgia being in a weak
 and low condition of body but of sound
 mind and memory calling to mind the
 uncertainty of this life and being desirous
 for to settle my worldly affairs before I
 go hence and be no more seen do—
 make and ordain this to be my last
 Will and Testament in the manner and
 form following: First I do desire
 that all my just debts should be
 fully and faithfully paid by the
 money arising from the sale of any
 part of my Estate or any other manner
 that my Executors shall think—
 proper I Will and bequeath unto
 my Son James Glynn the shilling
 Sterling Third I Will and bequeath
 unto my Daughter Ann Glynn
 one shilling Sterling Fourth
 I Will and bequeath unto my

Daughter Rebecca much my
storing money one shilling
fifth I will and bequeath unto
my son David (by act and to his
heirs and assigns for ever five
hundred acres of land it being
the improvements I bought
of James Baker to be granted at
the expense of my Estate. Sixthly
I will and bequeath unto my
son Samuel one bay mare saddle
and bridle or the money arising
from the sale thereof. Seventhly
I will and bequeath the remainder
of my Estate to be equally divided
between my wife Sarah (by act
and my two sons David and
Samuel. Eighthly I do appoint
my wife Sarah (by act and my
friend James Wakeham my
executors of this my last will
and Testament discharging

and forwarding all former Wills
and Testaments by me made known
whereof I have hereto set my hand
and Seal January Twenty Third 1790
