the three should die before
maturity then the share of the
one deceased to be divided equally
between the survivors and
goodly. As it is necessary that the
above may be done carefully &
justly I have by constitution
appointed my beloved sister
Catharine Leary and my friend
B. Jones Brown both of the
County of Surinam to my sole
executors empowering them
to sell said premises & apportion
the profits arising therefrom
as above directed to act & do in
all every respect as they my
sole executors may think for
the advantage of my family
