I then I will that at all my just Debts  
be paid and Satisfied Then I  
will that at all my Estate both real  
and personal be sold and be divided  
into Eleven Shares or parts -  
I then I will and bequeath to my  
beloved Wife Anna Mary Engel  
two Shares of my Estate -  
I then I do give and bequeath  
unto my five Children namely  
Hannah, John, Peter, the Refu-  
gion, and Joseph and Anne Engel

Salome Miller David Engel and  
Dannie Engel Joseph Engel and  
Christian Engel to have an equal  
part of the three shares left after their  
Mother having been the sole  
that my Executors do keep and detain  
in there then in those parts belong  
to my children who are not of age  
until they become twenty one years  
old to keep and detain in their  
hands that part belong to my  
Daughter Thora the said until  
her child be twenty one years  
of age or their Mother should die  
then and before that time lastly  
I do appoint and appoint my  
two beloved sons Christopher Engel  
and Sumner Engel my Executors  
of this my last Will and Testament  
to Witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and seal this twelfth  
day of January one thousand seven  
hundred and eighty six
