this my last Will and Testament set
in manner and form following that
is to say, first and principally
reign my soul with all humility
into the hands of Almighty God
my executor, humbly to beseech for
a full remission of all my sins -
through the merits and mediation
of my ever blessed Saviour Jesus
Christ; And my Body I commit to
the Earth, to be decently buried
at the discretion of my Executor
herein after named, And as to
such worldly Estate wherewith
it hath pleased God to bless
me; I dispose of the same as

the following Impressed Seals and direct
that all my just debts and funeral
charges be paid and satisfied as
soon as conveniently may be after
my decease. Item I give and bequeath
to my well beloved Son Subetham
the sum of Two entry shillings
being the money of the state of
Georgia and to my Daughter
Mary Sapp the sum of Twenty
shillings like money and I direct
that the said legacies be paid
to my said Son and Daughter
respectively within Six months
after my decease And that the
same be deemed paid and taken
in full of every right claim or
demand legal or equitable
which they or either of them
on any can or shall claim
against my Estate And that
the said Mary Sapp neither

for herself nor her heirs or either
of them or their heirs Executors or
Administrators or any other Person
or persons whatsoever now dead or
to come to be, may or can have
or claim against my Estate or
any part or parcel thereof
I give and bequeath to
my well beloved Grandson Thomas
Mann son of my son Luke Mann a
certain family of Negroes, by Name
Frank, Peg his wife and their
Children which together with
themselves make ten in number
with all their future issue and
increase also a certain tract of
land containing and bordering on
the North side of the Altamaha
River in the County of
Washington containing by

for ever. Now I give and
bequeath to my wife below

my son Luke a certain
parcel of 10 acres by name
fully surveyed and divided (which

issue and more as well as my
stock of ^{happily} cattle containing about
seventy head also a certain tract
of land on which I now reside
containing about two hundred
acres I think that my heirs
after named executor do and
shall or that his heirs executor
administrators or assigns do -
and shall faithfully peacefully
and quietly deliver to the above
named John James Jones at
the age of twenty one years all
the above described negroes
and cattle with every part of
them here are together with
the tract of land above
mentioned containing about
two hundred acres being on
little town site in Liberty County
Georgia and to hold the said

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Negroes cattle and land to him my
his heirs and assigns from that
time forward for ever Item I
direct that my hereafter
named Executor do sell and
dispose of all and every other
of my Estate of what so ever
kind it may be (except the
park first above mentioned)
together with my household
furniture and Chattels and the
Monies arising from the
sales to be equally divided
between my two above
named Grandsons and
lastly I do here by nominate
constitute and appoint my
said Son Luke Mason whole
and sole Executor of this my
last Will and Testament
and I hereby revoke and make
void all former and other Wills

by me at any time heretofore made
In Witness whereof I the said John
Mann have to this my last
Will and Testament (comprized
in the two first pages of one
sheet of Paper) set my hand
and seal and I have also set
my hand to the said two pages
at the bottom thereof at Little
Comuchie in Liberty town in
the State of New York this nineteenth
day of January in the Year of
our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and eighty six

testator as and for
his last Will and
Testament in the
presence of us who
