 until she marries in which
 case it is my Will & I do -
 Thereby Give to my said

born & married a free marriage
to her, her heirs forever to be
paid her by my Brother James
out of my estate & truly I
appoint my beloved Brother
James my sole Executor &
revoking all other Wills by
me heretofore made I do
pronounce this to be my last
Will & Testament in Witness
whereof I hereunto set my
hand and seal this twenty
ninth day of December in the
Year of our Lord the thousand
seven hundred & eighty six
Signed & sealed

in public & pronounced
solemnly by the John Moore (a)
testator and for his
last Will, Testament
in presence of us
the said seal
being first intimated

together with the said Deceased
