Robert Bolton Sr. Esq. in full and
State of Georgia made this 14th day
my 14th July in the Year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred & eighty
six being weak of Body but of
sound and disposing Memory, under
standing. With I commit my spirit
to God who gave it and my Body to
the Earth to be reverently buried and
my funeral charges & expenses may not
exceed seven hundred dollars and the
Estate with which it hath pleased
God to bless me I give devise
bequeath and dispose as follows
First I will that all my just debts
be paid and discharged as soon
after my decease as possible
Then I give and devise unto my
wife & affectionate son Robert
Bolton Junior all that my Town Lot
in Savannah which was bought by me the
third of the 11th of March 1784 and with
the improvements on said Lot to have
my son Robert his heirs & assigns

60 I give to my other sons that is
to say half the value of their
plantation, my Daughter to be
share equal in person and
property with my Sons, to be
educated & maintained till -
married one of my black
and she to have the choice of
anyone to go the whole church

This is the last Will and Testament of me
Robert Bolton Sr. of the County of Savannah
State of Georgia made this 11th day of June
1847 in the presence of me Lord
one thousand seven hundred & eighty
six being weak of Body but of
sound and disposing memory & under
standing. With I commit my spirit
to God who gave it and my Body to
the Earth to be reverently buried and
my personal estate as follows may not
witness seven hundred & fifty and the
estate with which it hath pleased
God to bless me I give devise
bequeath and dispose as follows
First I will that all my just debts
be paid and discharged as soon
after my decease as possible
Then I give and devise unto my
dear & affectionate son Robert
Bolton Junior all that my Town lot
in Savannah as mentioned in the
third & fourth articles of the
the same covenants on & sold to him
my s^r son Robert his heirs & assigns

And I also bequeath unto my son
son Robert all that forty five
acre lot with the Improvement
thereon situate in Hamstead four
miles from Savannah and between
the Highgate and White bluff-
roads to him my son Robert
his heirs & assigns for ever
I also bequeath to my son
Robert and his heirs & assigns
for ever all that tract of Land
containing five hundred fifty acres
of Land in the parish of St Paul
agreeable to the Grant now
in possession of my son
I also bequeath to my son
a Town lot in Portsmouth number
one hundred & twenty two. Also the
Town lot in Hardwicke number
eighty one I also bequeath to my
son Robert my featherman named
Quash the whole of the former
bequeath I give to him my son

Robert and his heirs for ever

I bequeath to my dutiful & affectionate
only Daughter Rebecca to have
all my Town Lot in favor and to be
known by the Number Three with
the Improvements there on also my
Negro Man named Peter which
I devise to her for her use for ever

I bequeath to my Grand Son Thomas
Kivell Junr One Town Lot in favor
known by the Number Two hundred &
fifty Seven, to him & his heirs for ever
I bequeath to my Grand Son
Robert Kivell and his heirs for
ever One Town Lot in favor
known by the Number Two hundred
& fifty eight

I bequeath to my Dutiful &
affectionate Daughter Ann
Adams my Negro Woman or
Pussilla with her Daughter
free with their heirs as for her
and her heirs for ever

I Bequeath to my dear affected
wife for her remarkable
good to my children myself
my Negro Woman Bella with
all her children namely Hannah
Doe & Lissa also all my stock
of cattle, except two cows called
old & young Blakney which I
desire to my son Robert and one
cow calf to Rebecca I have an
also desire to my dear wife
all my household furniture &
my Horse & Riding Chaise the
whole of which I bequeath to
my dear wife is for her use
during her natural life and
at her death the whole to be
divided am ongt my children
equally, I desire that my
adopted orphan child Rebecca
her use shall be maintained
by my dear wife as long as
my wife shall think proper to
keep her, and then its my desire

That my dear Daughter Rebecca
shall do the Charge of her and
have her educated to reading write
plain and keep her in the Character
of a Handmaid until she arrives
at the age of sixteen years.

I devise to my Grand Son Thomas
Adams and my Silver Watch -

I devise to my affluenced Neighbour
John Womack such of my old
wearing apparel as my Executors
shall think proper to give and
that my Executors shall pay to
John Womack Twenty Shillings
annum during his Natural life
to be paid out of my Estate
before hequeathment.

I devise to my Neighbour Jacob
Vies one of my best Suite of Cloths -
Lastly I devise that the residue
of my Estate not before disposed
off shall be sold by my Executors
to the best advantage and
after paying my just Debts -

demands & requires, then the
remainder to be equally divided
among my children -
Finally, I nominate constitute
and appoint my well beloved
Son Robert Bolton for the next year
in January and my kind &
affectionate son in Law Nathaniel
Adams of White Bluff I planted my
lawful Executors and my dear
wife to be my Executrix of this
my last Will & Testament and
in testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and here
to published the same as with
the day and Year first above
written -

and did see the said Testator sign
and publish pronounced and in
the same to be and contain his last
Will, Testament and that he was of
sound disposing mind then and
understanding to the best of his
Dignity and knowledge at the execution
thereof and that he the Testator
together with John Richardson & John
Hindle since deceased subscribed
their names as witnesses thereto at the
execution and in the presence of the said
Testator and in each others presence,
Done this 22nd May 1889. John Hamilton
