 at the discretion of my Executors
 nothing doubting but at the general
 resurrection I shall revive the same
 again by the mighty power of God
 and touching such worldly Estate
 as it has been pleased God to bestow
 me with in this life I dispose of in the
 following manner To my well
 beloved wife Mary I leave my Son
 Isaac and his Estate being six
 Negroes which was left him by
 his father he and then again I
 leave with her to support her

26 to my son comes of age. My tract
of land in Lashewes Neck North
Carolina Hanover County I leave
to my son Solomon the rights of
which is in Jacob Stichebys hands
which my said son will receive
on the 2^d of the Month of land.
My tract of land on Begetts
Neck I do will and bequeath to
my Daughter Mary Wad with all
improvements and rights to that
belongs thereunto to be disposed of
by her I like will appoint and
ordain my true friend John Gyspat
and my son Solomon Gyspat to be
my Executors to have every-
thing done according to this my
last Will and Testament in
Witness hereunto I have set my
Hand & Seal this 17th day of June
1768
