understanding do make and declare
this to be my last Will and Testament
In witness whereof I direct that all
such debts as I may justly owe be
paid and satisfied as soon as
conveniently may be after my
decease. Item I give devise be-
queath unto my Brother John
Tuff all my plantation or tract
of land in Newberry Township of
Albany County containing
more or less same more or less to
have and to hold the same to him
his heirs & assigns for ever.
Item I give and bequeath unto
my sister in Law Elizabeth
Crouch and the Sum of Twelve

108
Hundred specie dollars four
hundred of which to be paid
to her one Year after my
decease. Item All the rest &
remainder of my personal
Estate I give, bequeath to
my Sister Elizabeth Clark &
Brother in Law Edward Penchard
to be equally divided between
them share & share alike —

Subject to the following bequest
That is to say to my friend John
Fisher my Steed Horse known
by the name of Penchard
Saddle, Bridle and Cart & as
soon as born in the Constable
appointed my said friend John
Fisher, Joseph Miles to be
Executors of this my last Will &
Testament so Witness my Hand &
at this 16th day of January

in the Year of our Lord 1790

by the said Testator Simonson Tuff (21)
as and for his last
Will & Testament
in presence of us

J. G. Taylor

of Chatham in the State of Georgia?

Rider as one of the subscribing
Witnesses to the foregoing Will of
Simonson Tuff late of the said
County Merchant deceased
who being sworn on the holy
Evangelical of Almighty God
He swore that he

was present and did see the said
Testator sign & seal & pronounce
publish, declare the same to
be and contain his last Will &
Testament and that he was of
sound mind at the time to the
best of his deponents belief
and that John Hale and J. H.
Taylor together with this Dependent
subscribed their Names as —
Witnesses thereto at the request
and in the presence of the said
Testator, of each other
