by the Mighty Power of God and as Touching of such Worldly
Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this Life
I give demise and dispose of the same in the following man-
ner and form First I give and bequeath to Susannah my
dearly beloved Wife the one Third of the yearly income of my
Estate during her Life and to have the use of my Stock of
Cattle and Hogs during her Widowhood Also I give to my two
Sons Josiah and Elijah the remainder of my Estate to be
equally divided between them but should my Wife have
any more Children within Nine Months after my death be
she or they shall have an equal part of my Estate both real
and personal with my Son Josiah and Elijah And I do
appoint constitute make and Ordain my beloved Wife -
Susannah Executrix and my Brother Josiah Fox
Executor of this my last Will and Testament
