In the name of God Amen, David Montaigne of the City of Savannah Esquire do make this my last Will & Testament in manner following, that is to say, It is my Will and desire that after my decease my Negro Woman named Bella and her Children named London, Timna & Peter be set free & I do hereby / as I have heretofore by deed bearing date the Eleventh day of October one thousand seven hundred & Ninety, which I hereby confirm / Manumit enfranchise & set free the said several Negroes & the future issue & increase of the said several Negroes of and from all manner of bondage, Servitude & Slavery whatsoever on account of their attachment & faithful Services to me - And I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint John Glen of Savannah at Attorney at Law & John Wallace Esq. British Consul Executors of this my last Will & Testament - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the fourth day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety-five.
