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I last Will of W. Emanuel Doder, born at
Genes in Italy, residing some fifty years in the City of Mobile
Department of Bourke du Rhone were he as declared here. Wife
named Martha Samille Doder and a Father named with a
W. Chapus all actually residing in the City of Mobiles —

We Wills undressed being called by him to transport
myself at his lodging and he then declare to us that his
intention was to put order to his business. And we found the
Said Doder in good sound Reasonnement, for this effect he
transported himself from his bed into the next room where he
told us his last intention, as following. —

1st I declare and name for my Executors of this
Will W. John Blane, Born in the City of La Seale Departure
des Bouches du Rhone, residing actually in the City of Savannah
State of Georgia. for him to send in time what I left to my
Father Maria Doder Chapus or to her Children all actually
residing in the City of Mobiles. —

I said that I left and give to my Father Maria
Doder Chapus or to her Children in case of death of my said
Father the amount of Four hundred and eighty-six
Dollars — which we undressed Witness certify having
counted off with our hands and with W. John Blane,
as put up in the trunk of said Doder, who residing
and with him. —

2^{dly} I left and give a Negro boy to Mr. John
Blane, for the good service he as always
rendered to me, and he as being contented
in the same, also I give him the amount of

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of the Bill past between us Supposing I shall die before
the expiration of it as it is mentioned in the said
Bill.
