Solomon Penatton deceased of which I am the only
acting Executor I do hereby order and direct that the
management of the Same shall after my decease be
vested in my Executor herein after named with full and
ample power and Authority in Consil with the other
Executors named in his said Will if they or any one
or more of them shall think proper to qualify and Act
otherwise by himself to bring to Speedy & Close as possible
every Administration concerning the Estate of my Brother
Solomon Penatton deceased and fully Carry into effect
