Set my hand and Seal this tenth day of August in the Thirty-fourth year of the Union of our Sovereign Lord George the Third, by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c To fourth - And in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety-four
