of Maryland, do nominate this my
last Will and Testament being sound in mind
I submit my body to the grave hoping a
joyful Resurrection in the merits of my
Redeemer, after my funeral charges and
Just debts are paid, it is my Will the re-
maining part of my Estate be appropriated
in the following manner by my Executors who
will be hereafter named (viz) My Son Edmund
Jarvis after he arrives at the age of twenty-one
years, is to have one half my Estate by lot,
and the remaining half is to be my Son John
Jarvis when he arrives at twenty-one years.
My Executors are authorised to sell all my perish-
able goods such as household furniture, stock of horses
cattle and hogs and in case of necessity a negro to pay
my debts and are authorised to purchase for my
said Estate if they see fit. It is my Will, my Son
Edmund Jarvis be put to some Mercantile business
in January 1796 and be bound until he arrives
to the age of twenty-one years and my son John
Jarvis to be continued at School until January
1797 - and then to be bound to some calling whatever
best may suit his inclination - until he arrives
at the age of twenty-one years - Lastly, I leave
my friends Edward Henden, Robert Bolton, Hampton
Lillibron, Charles Dingsely my Executors to put this
my last Will and Testament in Execution - Witnessed
