of South Okech Chatham County, Widow, Being Weak in
body but of sound and disposing mind memory & under-
standing and Well knowing that I must one day or
other die, do make and declare this my last Will
and Testament, in manner and form following, that
is to say, after payment of my funeral Charges &
full satisfaction of all my just and lawful debts
I dispose of my estate as follows, which is one third
of the personal property now in my possession, which
the whole of the said one third I give and bequeath
unto my Son Benedict, to him his heirs, and assigns
for ever; And I give to my Son Henry twenty
Shillings Sterling. I give to my Daughter Mary
Ann, twenty Shillings Sterling. And I give to my Son
David Francis twenty Shillings Sterling. And I
give and bequeath to my dear Daughter Anne
Sophia, the Daughter of my Son David Francis,
one Negro Girl, to her, her heirs and assigns, for
ever. — And I do nominate and appoint
my Son Benedict, Executor of this my last Will
and Testament, hereby revoking any former Will
by me made, and declaring this only to be my last
Will and Testament. — I Witness whereof
the said Jane Judith Bouguier have hereunto set
my hand and Seal this 28. day of February in
the year one thousand seven hundred and thirty nine
