And I do likewise give devise and bequeath the residue of my said Estate after my said debts are paid & discharged that is to say, I give devise & bequeath to my dear beloved wife Henrietta Robert, all my money securities for money goods chattles estate & effects I do hold the same unto my said wife during her widowhood not doubting but she will so manage & conduct the business of my estate as to be for the interest & benefit of my children & in case my said wife should marry it is my desire that my said estate shall be divided unto three equal parts & that my said wife shall take one part thereof & the other two parts shall be given to my two children John Howell Robert & Thomas Robert Robert each of my said two children taking one of the said two parts & it is my desire that my son John Howell Robert should be given unto the care & management of Cornadell Gilbert.

And I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint my beloved wife Henrietta Robert & my beloved friend John Miller to be the executors & administrators of this my last will & testament hereby revoking & making void all & every other will & wills at any

Secondly all the rest of my Estate both real & personal
that is to say the Land whereon I now live &
the Negroes & the remainder of my stock of Cattle, & the
personal Estate I give & bequeath, unto my the six children,
Namely, Peter, Thomas, Sarah, Mary, John & Wm. Davies
or their legal Representatives to be equally divided among
any them, when the youngest of them comes of age & share alike.
Thirdly I hereby appoint & ordain my Son Wm. Davies
to be sole Executor to this my last will & Testament.
And I do hereby ordain, that he keep the whole
of the Estate together as it now is & work & manage
the same to the best advantage he is able for the
benefit of himself & five brethren & sisters aforesaid,
He shall rent out the new Settlement meadow
on younger land during the minority of William
