the uncertainty of human life Do make my Last Will and
Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) In the
first place I recommend my soul to the All mighty God who gave
it, my Body to be decently interred at the discretion of my
Exors. and Exors. herein after named. And as for such worldly
goods with which it has pleased God to bless me I give & dispose

and eighty five and whereon I have lately made a settlement.

And also all that other Tract of Land adjoining the said last mentioned Tract, containing one hundred & twenty five acres lately surveyed for me. - And also all that other tract of land containing Two hundred acres situate and being in the said County of Effingham & granted to me on the thirty first day of January, One thousand seven hundred & eighty five. And also all that other Tract of Land containing Two hundred & eighty seven and an half acres situate and being in the County of Washington on the Oconee River, originally granted to

I give and devise the same unto all and every the child & children
of my said Daughter lawfully to be begotten to be equally divided
between them if more than one, share & share alike to hold to them
their heirs and assigns forever - And in default of such child and
childrens Then I give and devise the said several Tracts and
Lots of Land, Negro Slaves and other the premises unto the eldest
Son of my Sister Hannah Fryd of the Province of Canada
Widow and the eldest son of my Sister Elizabeth Cockcroft wife
of John Cockcroft of the State of New York, Cordwainer, their heirs
& assigns forever -

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Mary, Executor, and my Friends William Lowder of the City
of Savannah, Carpenter, and John Eppinger of the same place
Bricklayer, Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby
revoking and declaring null and void all former & other wills by me
at any time heretofore made and declaring this only to be my last
Will & Testament. - In Witness whereof I the said John Nappert
have hereunto set my hand and Seal and to the four foregoing pages
have set my hand this day of September in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety two. and of American
Independence the seventeenth. -

Will and Testament and that he was of sound mind at the time
to the best of this disponent's belief, and that James, Thomson, Joseph
Welscher together with this disponent subscribed their names as
witnesses, at the request and in the presence of the said Testator and
of each other.
